This isn't a particularly special walk, but is a nice way to see different heath environments. The walk follows an old road which has now been turned into a service trail. There are many wildflowers and banksia along this walk, providing great flower displays in the warmer months of the year.

**Getting there** Traveling by car is the only practical way to get to Int. Sir Bertram Stevens Drive and Wisers Trk Gate South (gps: -34.1425, 151.0644). Car: There is free parking available. Traveling by car is the only practical way to get back from Int. Sir Bertram Stevens Drive and Wisers Trk Gate North (gps: -34.1121, 151.0599). Car: There is free parking available.

#### 0 | Int. Sir Bertram Stevens Drive and Wisers Trk Gate

*(1.3 km 23 mins)* From the southernmost 'Wises Track' sign on Sir Bertram Stevens Drive (sign to the left of the gate)(NOTE:this sign has been reported as missing by another walker), this walk heads away from the road and around the gate. The trail passes through the low heath to turn right after approximately 30m. After a short time more, the walk reaches a rocky outcrop (on the left) where it turns right, heading down the hill. The trail descends for some time to a clearing on the right, after which the trail heads steeply downhill, turning left. At the bottom of the rocky hill, the walk continues to the unsignposted intersection.

#### 1.33 | Int. Wisers Trk and Karani Trk

*(2.8 km 49 mins)* Veer right: From the intersection, this walk heads past a rocky outcrop (above on the left) as the trail heads downhill. The trail winds and undulates for approximately 2km along the ridge before coming to a grassy intersection.

Continue straight: From the intersection, this walk heads north, following the clearest trail for approximately 500m. The walk continues among banksia bushes and short eucalypts along the sandy trail, coming to an intersection with an overgrown trail on the left.

Veer right: From the intersection, the walk heads away from the fork in the track, along the defined trail. The trail soon passes the gate and 'Wises Track' sign, coming to Sir Bertram Stevens Drive.
